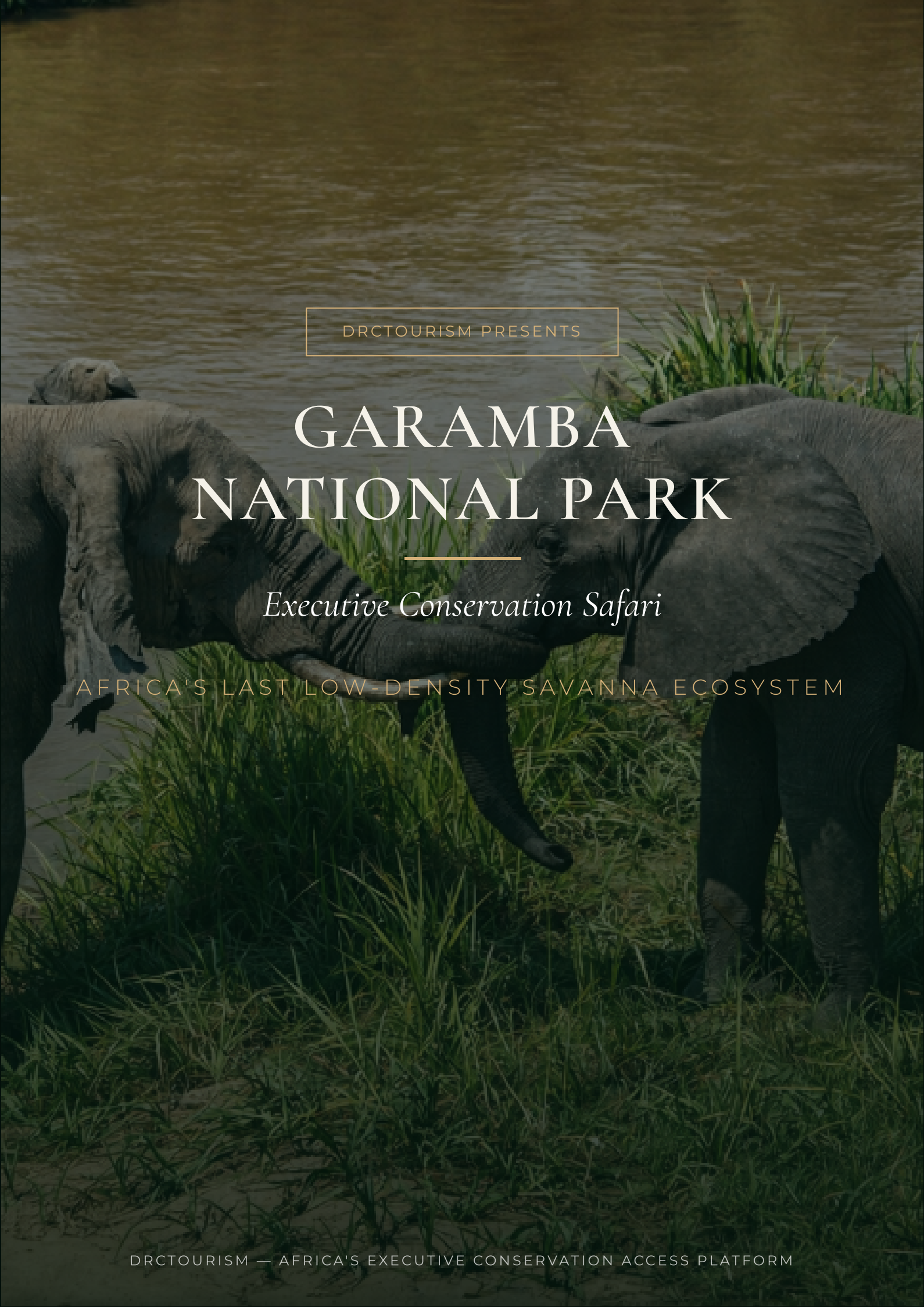

Garamba National Park is one of Africa's oldest protected ecosystems and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Located in the northeastern Democratic Republic of Congo, it remains one of the continent's most untouched savanna landscapes.

Unlike high-traffic safari destinations, Garamba operates within a conservation-first model — structured, ranger-coordinated, and low-density.

A Rare Wildlife Corridor

Garamba's vast savannas and woodland mosaics support a thriving, recovering ecosystem.

- The endangered Kordofan giraffe
- Lion and buffalo populations
